










Assembly

NOTE: A complete User's Manual is included on the Accessories and Manuals disc. The User's Manual includes additional details and safety notices.


1. Place the Controller on a solid level surface.

NOTE: For proper airflow, allow approximately 4 in. (10 cm) around the Controller.




2. Place the Recorder on the Controller.

NOTE: Use care to avoid pinching fingers.




3. Connect the USB cable between the Controller and the Recorder.




4. Connect the eSATA cable between the Controller and the Recorder.







5. Connect the Recorder power cable between the Controller and the Recorder.



6. Connect the Ethernet cable.




- 7. Connect the Controller power cord.
- 8. Configure the SmartDrive according to "SmartDrive Configuration" on page 17.




- 9. Install the SmartDrive.







- 11. Install the output bin.

13. Install the ramp.




14. Make sure that the ramp is fully seated on the Recorder floor.



NOTE: The two cutouts on the back edge of the rear lip of the ramp should be up against the tabs, not on top of them.







- 15. Connect the VGA cable between the Display and the Controller.
- 16. Connect the Display USB cable between the Display and the Controller.
- 17. Connect the Display power adapter cable to the Display, and the power adapter power cord to the same power outlet/circuit as the Controller.

CAUTION: The Display and Controller must be connected to the same power outlet/circuit.

Startup




1. Press the Controller power button.



2. Wait for startup to complete, indicated when the System status light is on. The light will be red if there is no ink cartridge installed.







3. Press the Display power button.

Media Loading

1. Open the Recorder top cover.




- 2. Press the Ink Cartridge Load button.
- 3. Wait for the ink cartridge carrier to finish moving from the disc transporter.




4. Open the ink cartridge carriage.







5. Remove the color ink cartridge tape.



6. Install the color ink cartridge.



7. Close the ink cartridge carriage.




Load the discs (white side up).CAUTION: Do not load clear protective discs.

9. Close the Recorder cover.




System Status




- 1. View the CD, DVD, and System status lights to see system status.
- 2. Press the System Information button to hear narrated system status messages.

Shutdown



- 1. Press and hold the System power button for about a second.
- 2. Wait for the lights to turn off.



3. Press the Display power button to turn off the Display.



SmartDrive Configuration

Remove the SmartDrive for Profile Editing

- If the SmartDrive is installed in the Controller, shut down Virtua E and remove the SmartDrive.
- 2. Insert the SmartDrive in a PC.

Set Network Information

- 1. Use a text editor to edit the file: \profiles\network\network.default.txt.
- 2. Make desired changes to:
 - ipAddress (the default static IP address is 192.168.1.202).
 - gateway consult your network administrator for this value or leave the default value if a gateway is not used.
 - netmask consult your network administrator for this value or leave the default value.

- 2. Enter the appropriate locale configuration code for the "locale" parameter.

Set Media Selection Mode

- 1. Use a text editor to edit the file: \profiles\system.txt.
- 2. To use Manual media selection mode, set the parameter doSmartDetectLoadedMediaType = false.

To use Auto media selection mode, set the parameter doSmartDetectLoadedMediaType = true.

- 1. Unmount the SmartDrive from Windows.
- 2. Remove the SmartDrive from the PC.
- 3. Reinsert the SmartDrive in Virtua E.
- 4. Start up Virtua E.

Host Settings for Storing DICOM Studies to Virtua E

AE Title	TCP Port	Description
Manual	104	Place studies in Study List for manual recording.
Auto	104	Automatically record studies, and automatically select the media type.
AutoCD	104	Automatically record studies on a CD.
AutoDVD	104	Automatically record studies on a DVD.

On Screen Keyboard



On Screen Keyboard allows character input from Display.

- 1. Touch characters.
- 2. Displays typed characters.
- 3. Press OK when done.


Log In

- 2. Touch the Password field. Type "codonics".
- 3. Touch the Log In button.




Set User Password

- 7. Touch the Save button.


View Site Information

- 2. Touch the Site tab.




Select the Media Type (Manual Mode)

- 4. Load the selected media type in the input bin.


Load Demo Studies



- 1. Touch the Utilities button.
- 2. Touch the Diagnostics tab.
- 3. Touch the Load button.




Set Date and Time



- 1. Touch the Setup button.
- 2. Touch the Date & Time tab.
- 3. Enter the Date.
- 4. Enter the Time.
- 5. Touch the Save button.

NOTE: Virtua E will reboot automatically.

Record Studies



- 1. Touch the Studies button.
- 2. Touch the Studies tab.
- 3. Select the Filter.
- 4. Select the Studies.
- 5. Touch the Record button.





6. Touch the Edit Options button.



- 7. Select a disc label.
- 8. Select DICOM viewer(s) to be included on the disc.
- 9. Set Make Auto-Run (optional).
- 10. Select the media type.
- 11. Select the number of copies.
- 12. Touch the OK button.






13. Touch the OK button to record the disc.

Software Installation

NOTE: New systems do not require software installation. Only perform these steps to install new software or when instructed by Codonics Technical Support.

- 1. Make sure all jobs are complete before installing software.
- 2. If not already on, power on Virtua E.
- 3. Open the Recorder cover.



- 4. Open the drive tray.
- 5. If there is a disc in the drive tray, remove it.
- 6. Place the Operating Software disc in the drive tray.
- 7. Close the drive tray, but leave the Recorder cover open.
- 8. Perform a soft shutdown by pressing and holding the System power button for about a second.
- 9. After the shutdown is complete, close the Recorder cover.
- 10. Press the System power button to start up Virtua E.
- 11. Wait for the software installation to complete and for Virtua E to reboot (which could take about 45 minutes), indicated when the System status light is green.

The Operating System disc should eject into the output bin.



Troubleshooting

Duablam	Calution
Problem System start up fails.	Verify that the power cords are connected. Press the Display power button to verify that the Display is on. Verify that the Display cables (VGA, USB) are connected. Verify that the Recorder USB cable is connected. Verify that the SmartDrive is connected.
Software will not install.	Verify that the SNATA cable is connected.
The drive not found.	Verify that the Recorder eSATA cable is connected.
The Display is blank.	Press the Display power button. Verify that the Display cables (VGA, USB) and power cord are connected.
The Display does not respond properly.	Verify that the Display USB cable is connected. Align Display by touching the Align Touch Screen button.
Login fails.	Verify the username. Verify the password case (uppercase and lowercase). Delete the file \profiles\user\user.admin.txt on the SmartDrive to restore the default password codonics.
The network is not responding.	Verify that the network settings for Virtua E at the sending host and on the SmartDrive are properly configured. Verify that the network cable is connected. Verify that the SmartDrive is connected.
The Recorder is not responding or is not found.	Verify that the Recorder USB cable is connected. Reboot Virtua E.
The printed label is blank, or the print is light or has lines.	Replace the color ink cartridge.
The system reports a disc error or the disc drive makes a rumbling noise.	Verify that the correct media type is loaded in the input bin. Use only recommended quality discs. Handle discs properly when loading them. Remove extra discs. Verify that a clear protective disc is not loaded.
System responses are slow.	Multiple jobs are being processed at the same time. Large jobs with many images are being processed. Multiple remote web connections are active. Check the status lights for an indication of the system status.
